What are the components of a solar panel?

The primary components of a solar panel are its solar cells. P-type or n-type solar cells mix crystalline silicon, gallium, or boron to create silicon ingot. When phosphorus is added to the mix, the cells can conduct electricity. The silicon ingot is then cut into thin sheets and coated with an anti-reflective layer.

The photovoltaic (PV) cell is the heart of the solar panel and consists of two layers made up of semiconductor materials such as monocrystalline silicon or polycrystalline silicon. A thin anti-reflective layer is applied to the top of these layers to prevent light reflection and further increase efficiency.
